Privacy Policy

Welcome to the JenniferErickson.net (“Website”) Privacy Policy. Use of the Website is subject to your acceptance of the Privacy Policy and the Terms and Conditions (“Terms”) found here. This policy informs you about the information we collect and how we use it.

We may collect personal and non-personal information when you provide it to us in the course of using the Website, enrolling in any of the programs or classes (“Classes”) we offer, using services or signing up for emails. The personal information that we may collect includes your name, mailing address, phone number, email address, or other personal information (“Personal Information”). The non-personal information that we may collect includes your browser type, the URL of the previous website you visited, your ISP, operating system, and your Internet Protocol (IP) Address (“Non-Personal Information”). Non-Personal information is not used by us to personally identify you and is not readily usable for that purpose.

Personal Information

We may collect personal identification information from you a variety of ways, including, but not limited to, when you voluntarily sign up to participate in a class or course or when you subscribe to a newsletter, and in connection with other activities, services, features, or resources we make available on the Website. You may also visit the Website anonymously. You can refuse to supply personal identification information but doing so may prevent you from accessing all parts of the Website or enrolling in a class.

How We Use Personal Information

We may disclose non-personal information (that does not identify you) without restriction. We may disclose Personal Information for the following:

- To third parties (including contractors, service providers, and Providers as defined in the Privacy Policy), and we use to support our business;
- To fulfill the purpose for which you provide it;
- To improve our offerings to you;
- For any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information and otherwise with your consent;
- To comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request.
- To enforce or apply our Terms, and any other agreements, including for billing and collection purposes.
- If we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of us, our customers, or others. This may include exchanging information with other companies and organizations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction. Sharing Personal Information
- We do not sell, trade, or rent your personal identification information to others.

We use Third-Party Providers (“Providers”) in order to provide Classes to you. Links to Providers’ terms of use and privacy policies can be found on our Terms.
